Application Requirements

- WB Music Therapy Internship Application (this document).
- Resume and Cover letter. Be sure to indicate clinical populations, whether they were individual or group sessions, and date range at each clinical site.
- Official transcripts from all universities attended.
- Three letters of recommendation sent by the writer.
 - one letter from the Academic Advisor
 - one letter from an MT-BC Clinical Supervisor
 - one letter from a supervisor of a non-music therapy related job or position.
- Video link or digital attachment of clinical skills:
 - A video of you singing and playing a song on the guitar that you would use during a session with an adolescent client diagnosed with Autism needing to develop appropriate social skills.
 - A video of you singing and playing a song on the piano that you would use during a session with an adult client diagnosed with an intellectual or developmental disability needing to engage with others using verbal and nonverbal communication.
 - A video of you singing a song a capella that you would use during a session with an older adult client who resides in a facility, is diagnosed with dementia and is anxious.
 - At least one of these songs must be with a mock client and include the goal and objective. Do not use actual clients.
- Using the videos above, provide 2 examples of clinical writing documentation based on the intervention you showed. (please adhere to HIPAA guidelines and be sure to remove names and identifying information)
